The options below are for students who received a Certificate of Completion (NOT a standard diploma)

- ❖ Take the FCAT again.
Call the Adult Community School Program at (561)649-6010 for information about the date.
- ❖ Take the ACT – 15 in Math and 18 in Reading can be used in place of FCAT as a passing score.
Take the SAT – 340 in Math and 420 in Reading can be used in place of FCAT
Call your high school counselor for information. There is a FEE to take these tests.
- ❖ Return to school for a 13th year and take only the courses you need to get a diploma.
Call your high school counselor for information.
- ❖ Enroll in an Adult Education program or Adult GED Program.

- ❖ Take a college placement test (P.E.R.T.) and attend Palm Beach State College
